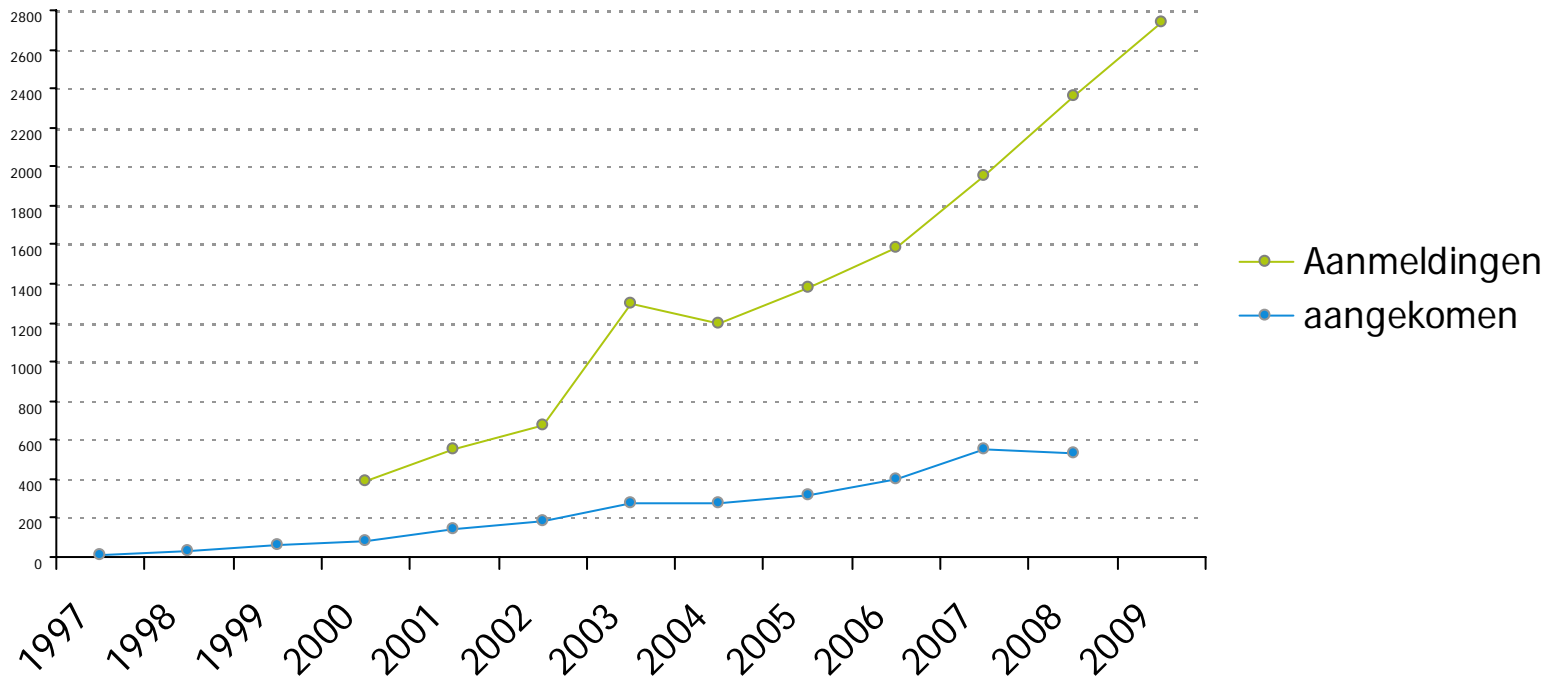

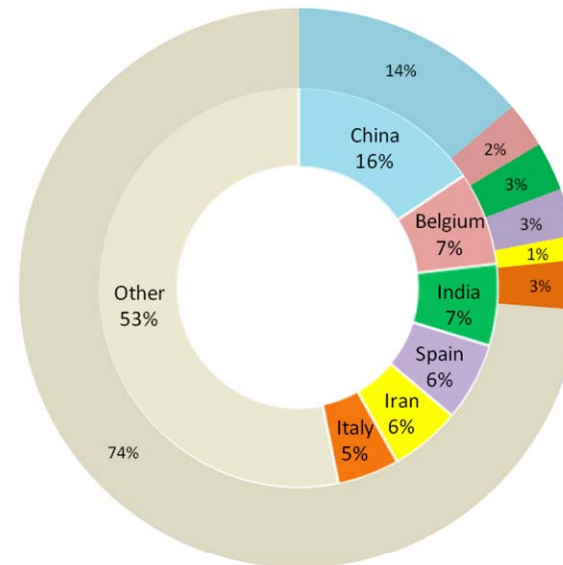

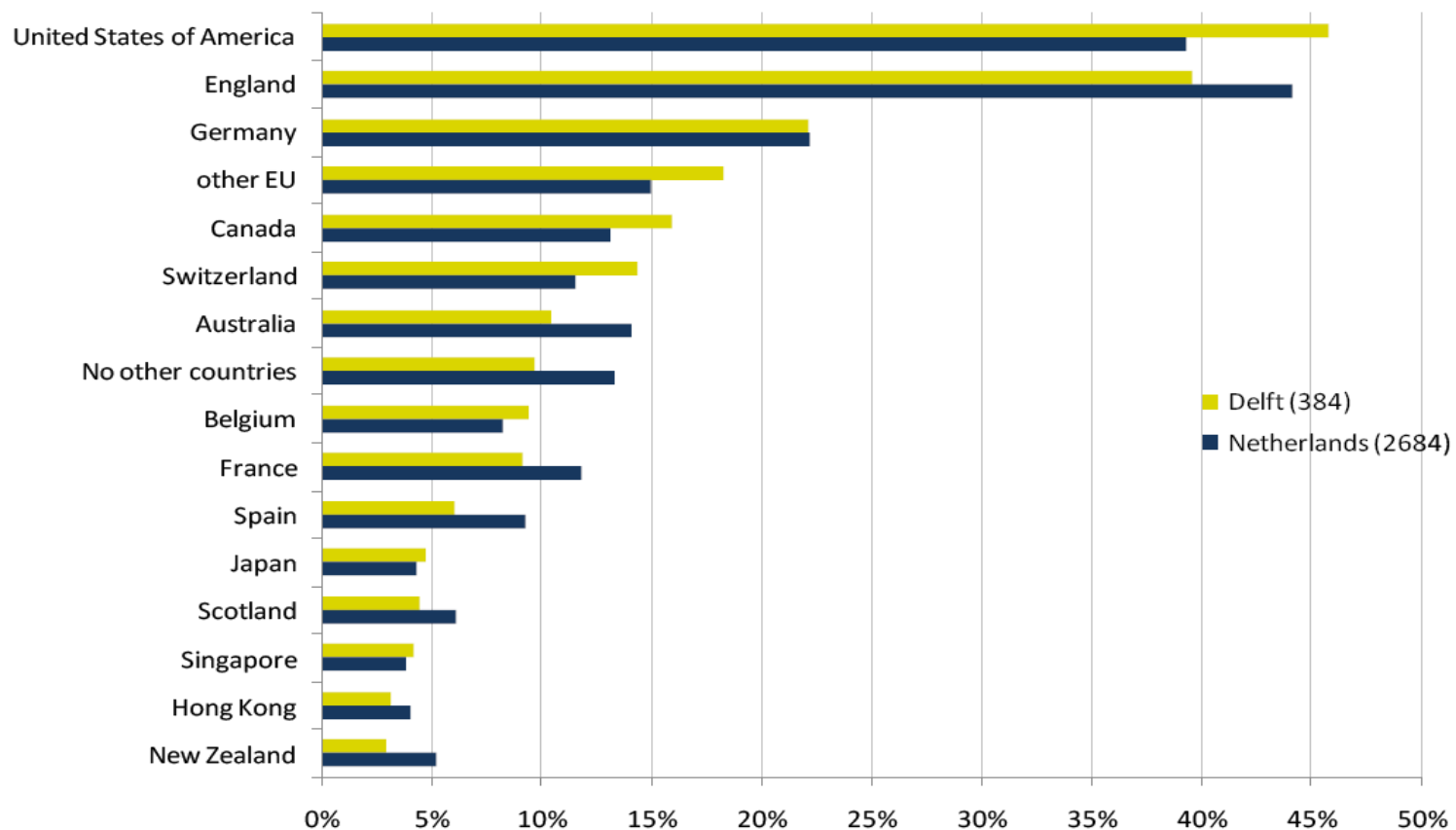

Which other countries did you consider?

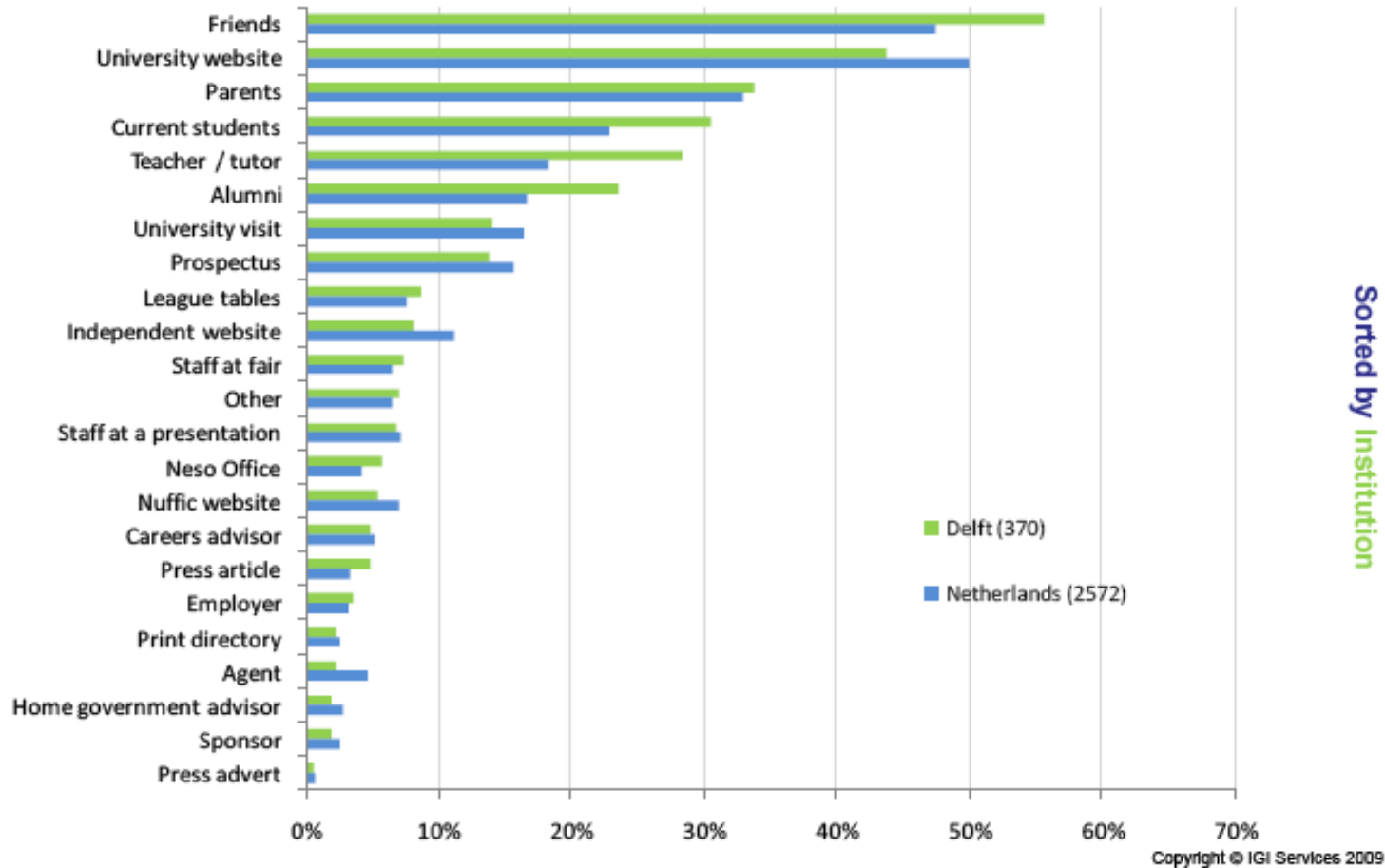

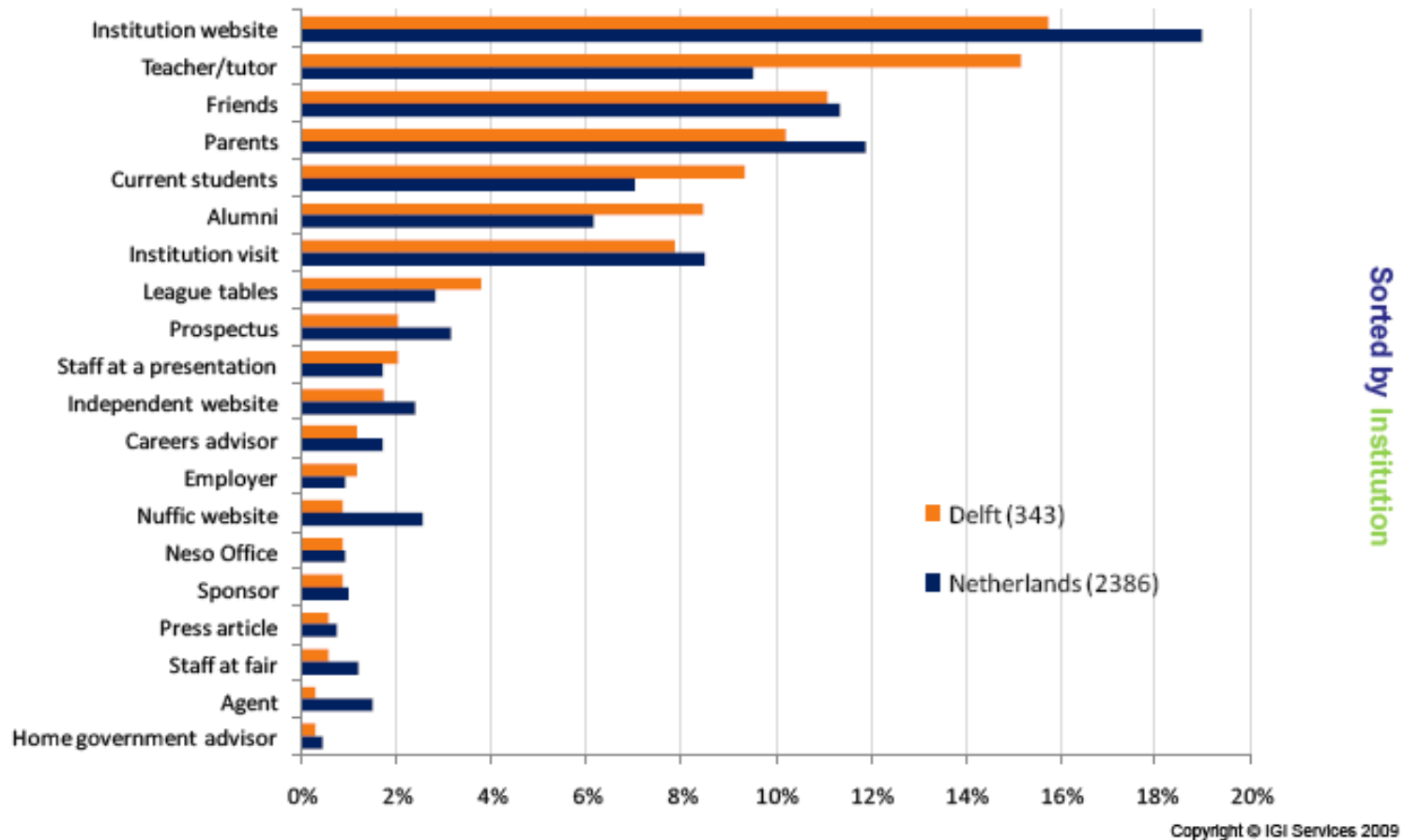

Which of the following factors helped you to choose your institution?



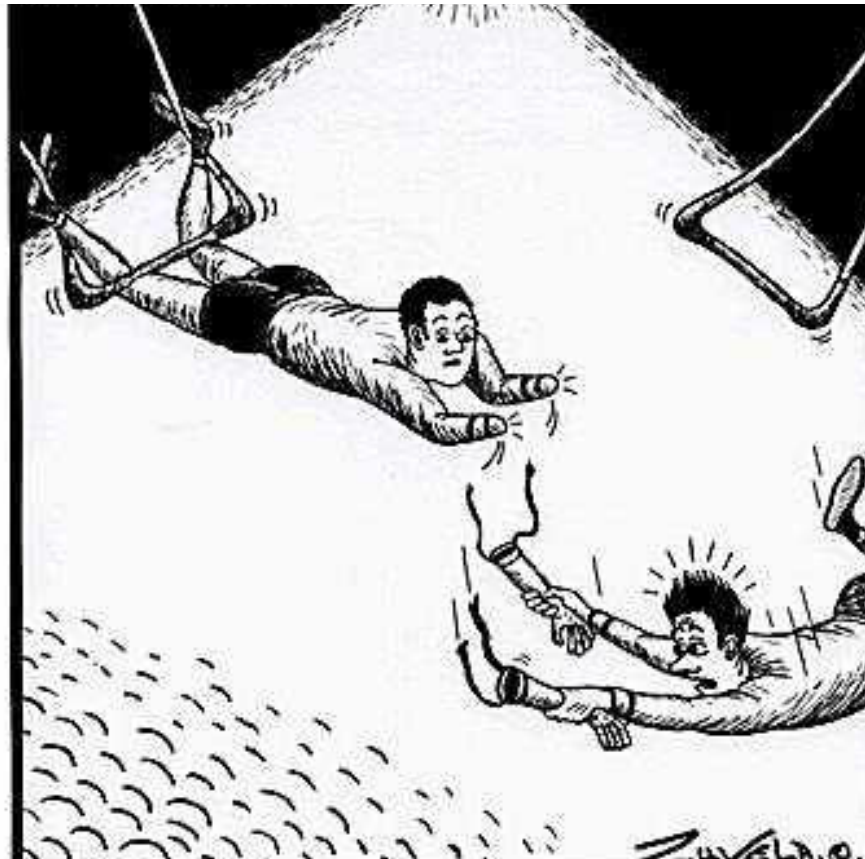

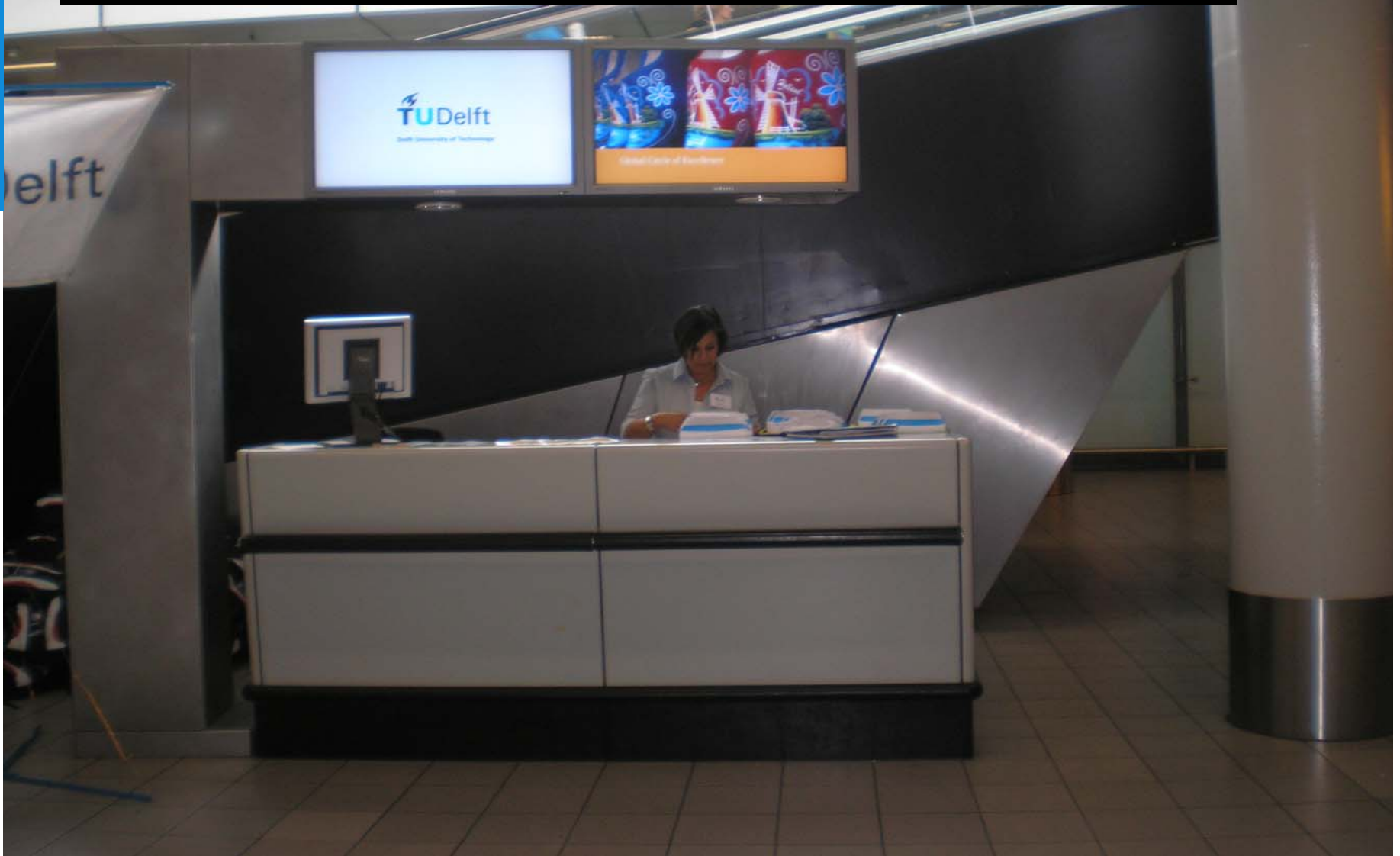

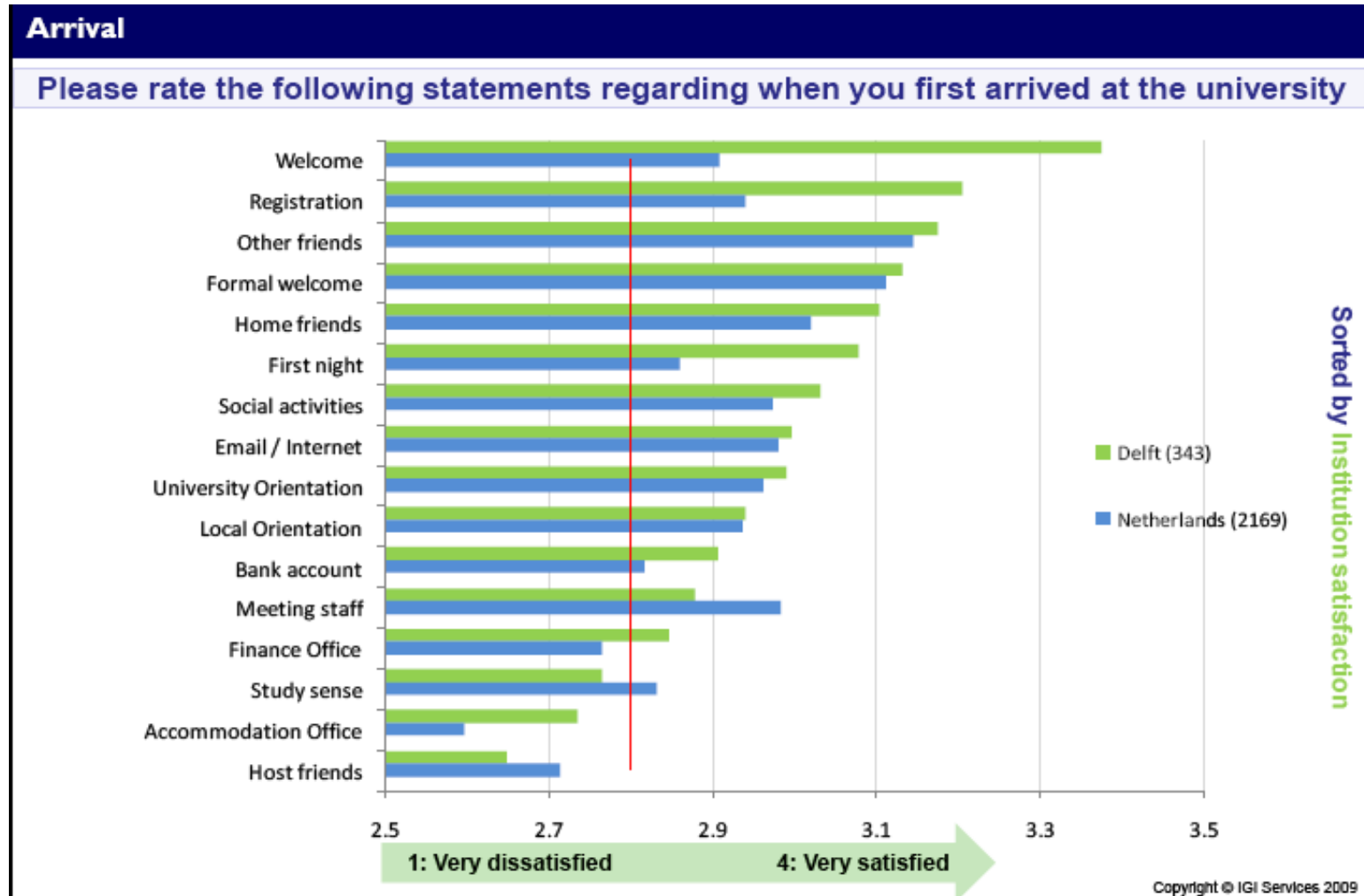
